Whereas, Pastor Lawrence co-chaired a fundraising campaign to purchase and install the first playground equipment at Golden Eagle Park; and

Whereas, Pastor Lawrence served as president of the Noon Kiwanis Club and served on the boards of the Fountain Hills Civic Association and Sunridge Foundation; and

Whereas, Pastor Lawrence served on the Fountain Hills Town Council for five years including one term as Vice Mayor; and

Whereas, Pastor Lawrence served as spokesman for the school bond promotion committee and the spokesman and co-chair of the Citizens for the Widening of Beeline Highway Action Committee; and

Whereas, Pastor Lawrence is the founding Pastor of Christ's Church of Fountain Hills where he has ministered since 1984; and

Whereas, Pastor Lawrence has chaired numerous times and continues to be an active participant of the Fountain Hills Ministerial Association; and

Whereas, Pastor Lawrence was voted to the list of the town's top 20 volunteers in 1991 and was inducted into the Lower Verde Valley Hall of Fame in 2007;
