NOTICE OF THE GENERAL AND SPECIAL ELECTION MAY 18, 2010

DATES TO REMEMBER

On Tuesday, May 18, 2010, the Town of Fountain Hills will hold a (i) a General Election for seats where no candidate was elected at the March 9, 2010, Primary Election, if a run-off election is necessary; and (ii) a Special Election for qualified voters to decide one proposition.

Only **one** publicity pamphlet, which contains the sample ballot, will be mailed to each household in which a registered voter resides on or around April 22, 2010, and will include information on polling places, the proposition and candidates, if a run-off election is necessary.

The mailing label on the publicity pamphlet will indicate where voters should go to vote. *Please make it available to all registered voters in the household.*

On-site early voting **will not** be offered at the Fountain Hills' Town Hall, but will be offered at the three Maricopa County Recorder Election satellite locations (see right column for locations).

Polling places are open from 6:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Five (5) polling places will be used for the Town's nine (9) precincts:

Monday, April 19, 2010

Voter registration closes at 5:00 p.m. Voter registration is processed through Maricopa County Elections. In order to be eligible to vote in the May 18, 2010, General and Special Election, voters must have submitted their registration application to Maricopa County Elections by April 19, 2010.

Tuesday, April 20, 2010

Logic and Accuracy Test: Equipment used to record votes will be tested at **2:00 p.m.** at the Maricopa County Tabulation and Elections Center, 510 South 3rd. Avenue, Phoenix, AZ (3rd Ave. & Lincoln). The public is welcome.

Thursday, April 22, 2010

- **Publicity Pamphlet/Sample ballots** available for public inspection at Town Hall.
- **Early ballots** available. Qualified voters can vote early (i) by mail or (ii) in person. Qualified voters can vote in person at the following Maricopa County Recorder's election satellite locations:
 - **111 South 3rd Avenue, Phoenix, AZ 85003**
 - **510 South 3rd Avenue, Phoenix, AZ 85003**
 - **222 East Javelina Drive, Mesa, AZ 85210**

- **Vote by mail:** Ballot Request Cards are found at Town Hall, the Library, and the Community Center. Completed Ballot Request Cards must be mailed to Maricopa County Elections **before and received by Friday, May 7, 2010**. Registered voters may also contact Maricopa County Elections at **602-506-1511, 602-506-7008**, or through the Maricopa County Recorder's website at <http://recorder.maricopa.gov>.

Voted early mail ballots may be returned to Maricopa County Elections by mail, placed in the sealed ballot box at Town Hall **prior** to Election Day, or dropped off at any polling place **on** Election Day.

Thursday, May 13, 2010

Logic and Accuracy Test: Equipment used to count ballots will be tested at 2:00 p.m. at the Maricopa County Tabulation and Elections Center, 510 South 3rd. Avenue, Phoenix, AZ (3rd Ave. & Lincoln). The public is welcome.

Friday, May 14, 2010, 5:00 p.m.

Deadline to vote early **in person** at the three Maricopa County Recorder's election satellite locations.

Tuesday, May 18, 2010, is Election Day

Polls open 6:00 a.m. - Polls close at 7:00 p.m.
