WHEREAS, it is important for the Town of Fountain Hills to continue to provide the excellent delivery of services and programs that our citizens have come to expect in our community; and


WHEREAS, it is one of the responsibilities of town officials to ensure open and accessible government through frequent communication with citizens using various avenues and means; and


